



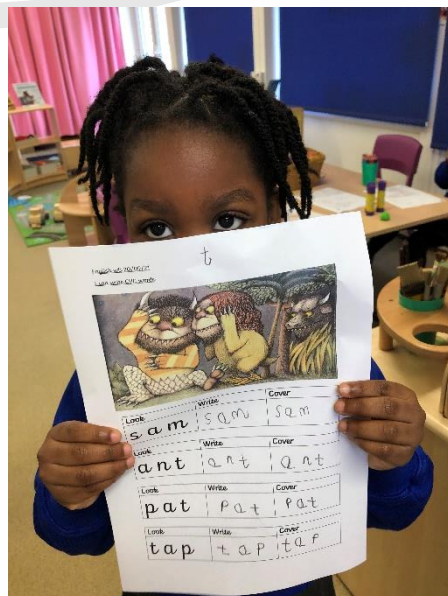
St Barnabas C of E Primary School – Autumn Term Newsletter 2- 2021
