Dear Parent and Carers,

We are writing to inform you that there are several cases of Chicken Pox across the school. If your child shows the following symptoms, please contact school.

- Raised pink or red bumps
- Fluid filled blister bumps
- Crusts and scabs that cover the broken blisters
- Fever
- Loss of appetite
- Headache
- Tiredness and a general feeling of being unwell



You child will only need to be off school if they have the rash. The exclusion period is 5 days after the appearance of the rash and all blisters have crusted over.

If your child does have Chicken Pox please seek advice from your local pharmacist.
